**MINUTES OF THE 79<sup>TH</sup> MEETING OF BOARD OF GOVERNORS HELD AT 4. PM ON 26.6.2008 IN THE CONFERENCE HALL, ROOM NO. 112, 'C' WING SHASTRI BHAWAN, NEW DELHI**

The 79<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Board of Governors of Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan was held at 4 PM on 26<sup>th</sup> June 2008 at Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi. Vice-Chairman, KVS presided over the meeting. The list of members who attended the meeting is at **Annexure— 'A'**

The Commissioner, KVS welcomed the Vice-Chairman, KVS, Shri Ashok Thakur and other distinguished members of the Board.

Highlighting the achievements of the students of Kendriya Vidyalayas, Commissioner, KVS informed that there has been consistent growth in number of students appearing at the CBSE secondary and senior secondary school examinations. In the year 2008, 55,393 students of standard XII appeared at the Board exam as compared to 36,041 students in 2003. In standard X, as compared to 53,065 students who appeared at the Board examination in 2003, 75,713 students appeared at the said exam in 2008.

Over the last five years there has been both quantitative and qualitative improvement in results of Kendriya Vidyalayas. The pass percentage in CBSE Class X Board examination has risen from 95.64% in 2007 to 96.07 % in 2008. In Class XII Board examination, the pass percentage is 91%.

In class X, Master Vignesh Venkatachalam of Kendriya Vidyalaya, CLRI Chennai has topped in CBSE with 99% marks in aggregate. In Class XII, Master Piyush Suraj Raathor of Kendriya Vidyalaya, Itanagar-2 is the KVS topper with 96.8% marks in aggregate. Incidentally the students of KVS are CBSE toppers in class X consecutively for the last three years.



The qualitative performance of the students has also shown marked improvement in the last five years. In class X, the percentage of students securing marks in the range 75% and above has risen from 31.62 % in 2007 to 32.40% in 2008. Similarly the percentage of students securing 90% and above marks has risen from 4.15% in 2007 to 4.67% in 2008. In class XII, the percentage of students securing 90% or more marks was only 0.73% in 2003 which has increased to 1.52% in 2008.

The number of students getting merit certificates for their performance in various subjects in class X Board examination has increased from 827 in 2003 to 1263 in 2008. Such merit certificates for class XII Board examination increased from 348 in 2003 to 391 in 2008.

Commissioner, KVS also highlighted the achievements of the students in other scholastic areas. He informed that in Mathematics Olympiad conducted by the National Board of Higher Math., out of 36 students selected at the national level, 5 students were from Kendriya Vidyalayas in 2007. Out of them Master Utkarsh Tripathi of Kendriya Vidyalaya IIT, Kanpur received certificate of appreciation after representing India at the international competition at Hanoi (Vietnam). Three Kendriya Vidyalaya students figured in the list of selected candidates at national level for this year's Mathematic Olympiad. In Physics Olympiad, Master Rohit Singh of Kendriya Vidyalaya ONGC Dehradun was selected for participation in International Physics Olympiad 2007 held in Iran and received a Gold medal. Master Vijay Suralkara of Kendriya Vidyalaya, Bhandup, Mumbai won the silver medal in International Earth Science Olympiad in 2007. Five students received scholarships under the Kishore Vaigyanik Protsahan Yojana for the year 2007. In NTSE, out of 2000 scholarships awarded by NCERT, 76 scholarships have been awarded to Kendriya Vidyalaya students. Master Rishin Behl of Kendriya Vidyalaya Mankurd, Mumbai has won five awards at the Intel International Science and Engineering Fair 2007 held in U.S.A.

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Students of Kendriya Vidyalayas are also doing exceedingly well in various competitive exams. As per latest information received, 207 K.V. students have been successful in IIT entrance examination - 2008.

Commissioner further informed that there was a need for sanctions for new KVs. Out of the total 981 schools sanctioned so far 979 are functional. 44 matured proposals are awaiting sanctions from MHRD. In this meeting opening of KVs at 9 more places are being proposed. Meanwhile the enrolment position of Kendriya Vidyalayas has steadily increased and would be crossing the 1 million mark shortly. This itself speaks of the popularity of the Kendriya Vidyalayas. KVS also has been assigned the top position in the education sector by the Brand Equity survey for the third consecutive year.

Vice-Chairman, KVS desired that the Kendriya Vidyalayas showing exemplary results may be identified and suitably awarded.

Thereafter the agenda items listed for deliberations were taken up by the Member-Secretary for consideration of the Board.


It was also decided that detailed guidelines for expenditure on sports and adventure activities should be formulated and incorporated in the Accounts Code.

**ITEM NO 6 LIBRARY POLICY- ADOPTION AND INCORPORATION IN EDUCATION CODE FOR K.Vs.**

The Board approved the proposed Library policy for incorporation against Article 137 and 138 of the Education Code with the modification suggested for Clause 5 of the said policy as follows:

After approval by the Library Committee, the teacher may be allowed to purchase the intended book(s). The cost of the book/books should be reimbursed to the teacher after the books are deposited in the library along with the bill. However, this kind of purchase would be limited to only a certain amount that would be decided by the Library Committee.</p>

**ITEM NO 8[I] CHANGE OF SECTOR OF KENDRIYA VIDYALAYA, VAYU SENA NAGAR (VSN), NAGPUR FROM DEFENCE SECTOR TO CIVIL SECTOR.**

The Board approved the proposal to change the status of Kendriya Vidyalaya, (VSN) Nagpur from Defence Sector to Civil Sector.

**ITEM NO 8[II] CHANGE OF SECTOR OF KENDRIYA VIDYALAYA, DGI COMPLEX, CHENNAI FROM CIVIL SECTOR TO DEFENCE SECTOR**

The Board approved the proposal for change of Kendriya Vidyalaya DGI Complex from Civil Sector to Defence Sector.

**ITEM NO 9 [I] TO CONSIDER ACCEPTANCE OF LAND ON 30 YEAR LEASE PERIOD FOR CONSTRUCTION OF SCHOOL BUILDING, STAFF QUARTERS AND OTHER INFRASTRUCTURE FACILITIES IN RESPECT OF KVs OPENED UNDER CIVIL SECTOR SPONSORED BY STATE GOVERNMENTS /UTs.**

The Board approved the proposal to make a departure from the laid down norms by accepting land on lease for an initial period of 30 years only with a commitment to get the lease period extend by the State Government/U.T from time to time upto a total period of 99 years for the KVs sponsored by all the State Governments/UTs. However, it was suggested that there should be a separate clause that at the end of the lease period, the lease on the land would be renewed immediately.

**[II] TO CONSIDER COMMENCEMENT OF CONSTRUCTION WORK ON LAND HANDED OVER TO KENDRIYA VIDYALAYAS BY STATE GOVERNMENTS ON PERMANENT GRANT BASIS, PENDING ISSUE OF GOVERNMENT SANCTION ORDER**

The Board approved the proposal with the following instructions:-

- a) Land in question should be clearly demarcated at site and the sponsoring authority should deliver advance possession as per rules





- b) KVS should follow up with the sponsoring authority to obtain sanction order for permanent grant as early as possible.

**ITEM NO 10** TO CONSIDER THE PROPOSAL OF ENTRUSTING KVS WORKS OF SCHOOL BUILDINGS AND STAFF QUARTERS TO DEPARTMENT OF HYDRO POWER DEVELOPMENT (DHPD), GOVT. OF ARUNACHAL PRADESH

The Board approved the proposal to entrust KVS works of school buildings and staff quarters to the Department of Hydro Power Development (DHPD), Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh.

**ITEM NO 11** INCLUSION / DELETION OF THE NAMES OF THE KENDRIYA VIDYALAYAS FROM THE EXISTING LIST OF HARD/VERY HARD STATIONS.

The Board approved the list of Hard/Very Hard stations notified by KVS as per Annexure-'D'. It was however, desired that the case of K.V. Karanja which has been de-notified from the list of hard station, be reviewed and decided as per norms.

**ITEM NO 12** NORMS FOR SANCTION OF POSTS OF PET/WET/DRAWING TEACHER/YOGA TEACHER

It was decided that the proposal recommended by Academic Advisory Committee be placed for consideration of Finance Committee and then placed before the Board for consideration.

**13. ANY OTHER ITEM:**

The Board also passed the following resolutions:

- i) to consider raising the pay-scales of teachers above the level of pay-scales of teachers serving under State Govt.
- ii) to raise the age-limit of lady teachers for the purpose of recruitment to the post of PRTs.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
